REGULATION AND REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ALLOCATION OF SCHOLARSHIPS FOR BENEDETTO XV INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL OFFERED BY GBR UNIPERSONALE SRL TO ITALIAN AND FOREIGN STUDENTS

DEADLINE 20 MAY

1. PREMISE

The soc. GBR SRL provides a maximum of six Scholarships for Italian and foreign students interested in enrolment for Middle School at the Benedetto XV International School.

The request to participate in the selection IS NOT considered a registration form. There is NO obligation to register or to pay any fee.

2. PURPOSE OF THE SCHOLARSHIPS

The scholarships are offered to encourage deserving students to undertake an academic path of excellence. The Scholarships provided by GBR Unipersonale are valid for ONE year, and are renewable for the entire duration of the Middle School (corresponding to years 7, 8 and 9). We firmly believe that facilitating the access of youth to educational paths of excellence contributes to laying the foundations for a society of responsible, competent and supportive citizens.

3. SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS

The Scholarships are open to students from other schools that are interested in enrolling in the Middle School of Benedetto XV International School. Students currently on scholarship are also eligible to renew their scholarship on a yearly basis.

4. VALUE OF SCHOLARSHIPS

GBR Unipersonale will provide a maximum of six Scholarships to partially cover the Tuition Fee.

The following remain at the expense of the candidate:

- the Registration Fee
- the Capital Assessment
- anything not included in the Tuition Fee

5. REQUIREMENTS

Applications can only be submitted by students who meet the following requirements:

a. School grade average

Students of Italian and foreign citizenship who have received in their last report (the one relating to the current school year) an average of not less than:



- B for Year 6 for the British curriculum;
- 8 (Avanzato) for the 5th year of elementary school, for primary school, or for the first year of Italian middle school;
- The highest level of the behaviour grade

b. Educational qualification

Students of Italian and foreign citizenship in possession of a qualification valid for enrolment in the Italian Middle School (first, second or third year) or Year 7, Year 8 or Year 9 of the British curriculum (and corresponding to international programmes).

c. Language requirements

Candidates must have a good level of written and spoken English. To verify this knowledge, students must take a test at Benedetto XV International School.

6. SELECTION AND ASSIGNMENT OF SCHOLARSHIPS

a. Commission

The evaluation of the requests will be carried out by a commission composed of teachers and members of Benedetto XV International School's management.

b. Award criteria

Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of a ranking that will take into consideration the following merit criteria:

- Scholastic results of the last 2 years;
- entrance test (to be held at Benedetto XV International School);
- individual interview in which the student's personal and academic profile (personal and academic goals) and personal motivation will be assessed.
- the interview will take place in English and Italian;
- personal achievements in the academic field (awards, publications, etc.) and in other fields (participation in voluntary and community service initiatives);
- candidates' self-introduction letter, including a description of their academic and personal profile and the reasons for their candidacy.

The Commission will evaluate the requests and will communicate the results to the awarded students.

7. SCHOLARSHIP OBLIGATIONS AND MAINTENANCE OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

1. Obligations of scholarship recipient

The scholarships have a duration of ONE year, corresponding to one academic school year in the Middle School, and are renewable for up to THREE years, so as to cover the entire duration of the



Middle School (years 7-9). To qualify for the renewal of the scholarship for the following year, the awardee must comply with the following obligations:

- maintain good academic results (average not less than 8, the highest level of the behaviour grade);
- contribute as an active and positive member of the school community;
- demonstrate constant attendance and punctuality.

2. *Revocation of the scholarship*

The members of the school management reserve the right to revoke a scholarship if the grades, attitude, behaviour, attendance and punctuality of a student are considered unsatisfactory.

7. SUBMISSION OF THE APPLICATION

a. *How to submit new applications*

New applications for selection relating to the assignment of scholarships must be sent exclusively by email to

admissions@benedettoxv.com with the subject "SCHOLARSHIP REQUEST".

All applications must be submitted by May 20th, 2023 at 2:00 pm (Italian time).

b. *Requested documents*

The candidate's parents / guardians must download and fill in the form that is available on the school's website and send the completed form with the following documents also in attachment:

- Identity documents of the student and parents / guardians;
- Last two report cards;
- Candidate self-presentation letter;
- Letter of academic references from a teacher of the candidate;
- Certificates or Titles (if awarded)

c. *For the renewal of the scholarship the commission will evaluate the second term report.*

d. *Exclusions and Liability*

Any applications received after the deadline will not be accepted.
